The United Kingdom is one of the world's wealthiest countries and the 4th largest e-commerce market.



E-commerce revenue is expected to reach \$160.6bn in 2024 comparable to \$143.9bn (2023) – an 11.61% increase.



E-commerce user penetration is currently **83.1%** (2023) and expected to hit 86.3% by 2027.

Cross-border e-commerce attitude:

Based on the IPC survey results from 2022 – 20% of the United Kingdom always know the location of the e-retailer they buy from.

In 2022 – 50% of participants from the United Kingdom who participated in the IPC survey agreed on the following statement, "It makes no difference to my online shopping decision if the e-retailer I am buying from is foreign-based or based in my own country."
